

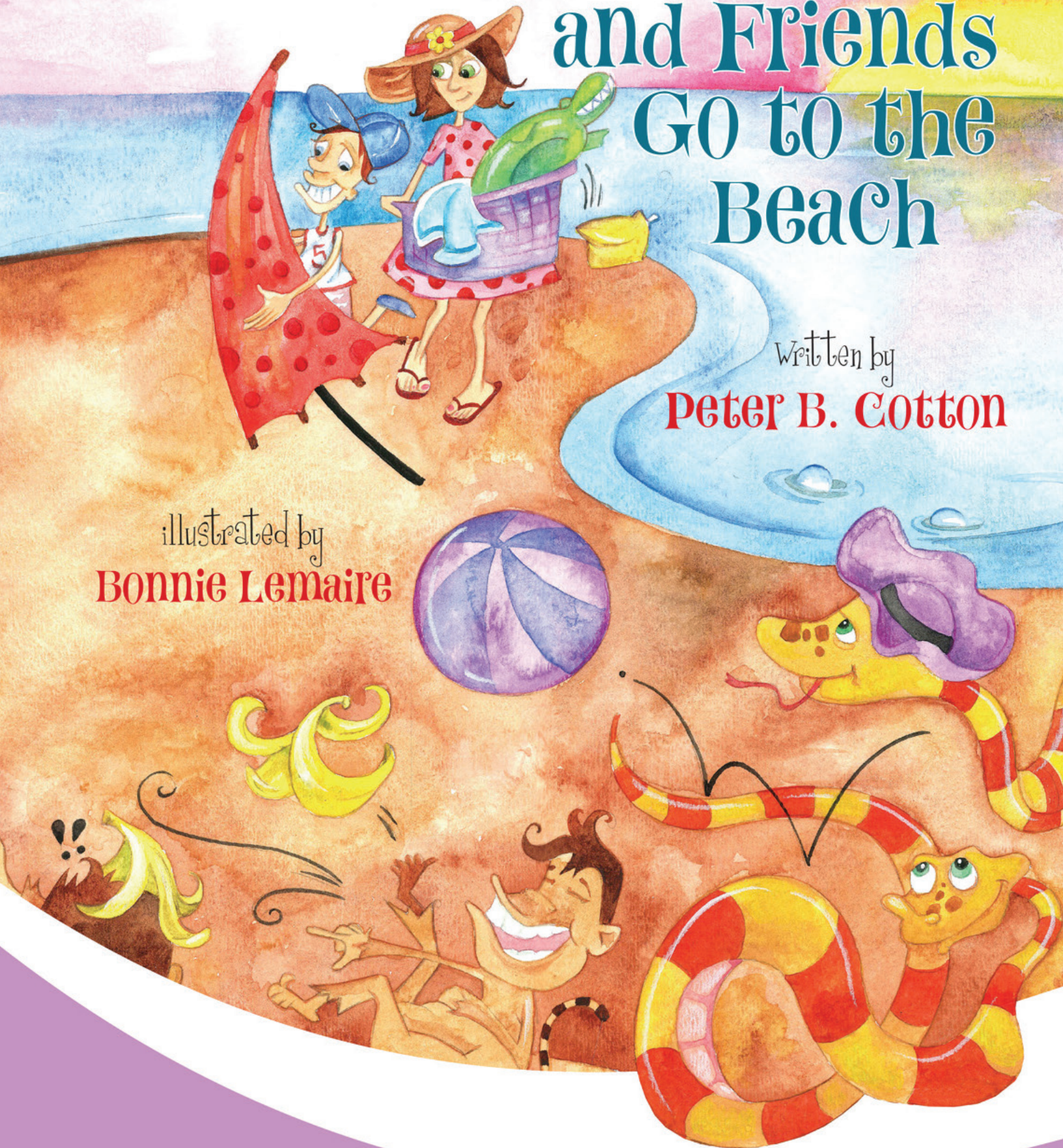
When Fred The Snake and Friends Go to the Beach

Dad appeared.

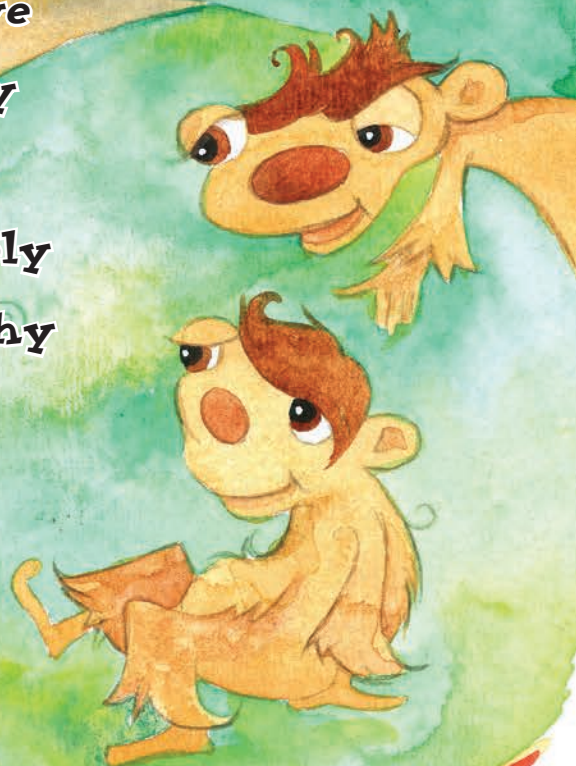
Wow, he's grown
a bushy beard!




**He hugged Mama, young Jack too,

stuff together".**






**You'll need swimsuits,
