**Where to next? Fred, you choose.**

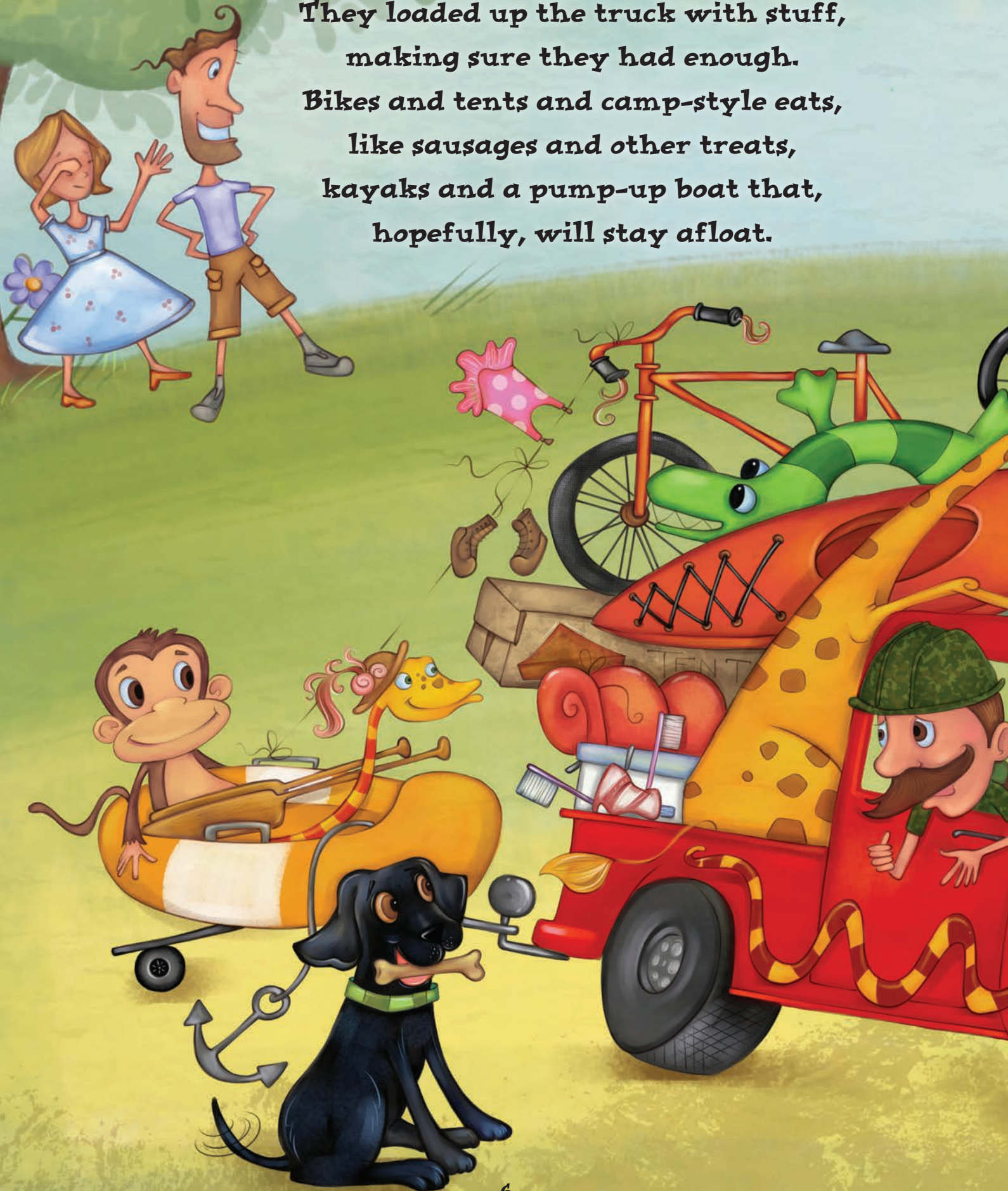
**Big cities, playgrounds,

said OK, provided Jim will lead the way.

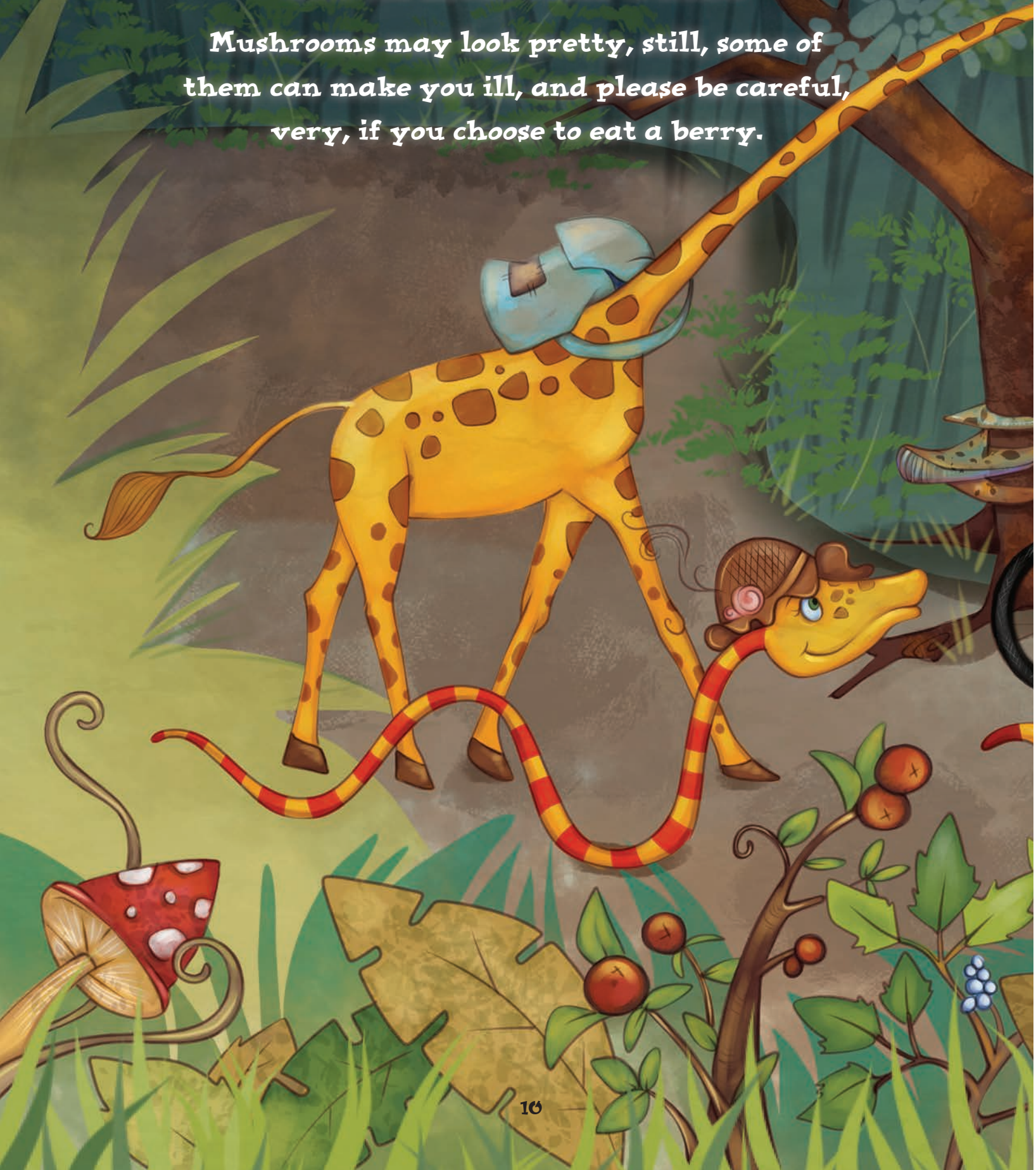


**They loaded up the truck with stuff,
